

St Andrew and St Mark, Surbiton: 2018-9

Our Mission Action Plan priorities for 2018 onwards:

- **Congregation:** to grow our Sunday attendance by 10% in the next three years
- **Welcome:** to ensure that any newcomer feels welcomed at the level at which they wish to enter, be that to join a home group or just occasional visiting
 - In 2018-9 to develop five new instruments of communication, using both traditional channels (banners, signage, noticeboards) and social media (Facebook page, twitter)
- **Discipleship:** to secure in their development the three home groups currently going, alongside offering other discipleship courses
 - In 2018-9 this will include a prayer workshop, attended by over 20 people
 - In 2018-9, this will include the Gresham lectures
- **Social action:** to continue our work supporting local homeless people, including through support for the Joel Community project at least two nights a month throughout the year, and the annual winter Nightshelter.
- **Children:** to continue with our young children's work, but to develop activities for children aged between 9 and 12 that they feel continued connection with the church.
