

Mission Units

The Deanery is presently consulting with PCCs as to the form of Mission Units (leaving aside the 6 Villages, already a Mission Unity). With regard to St Mary & St Hugh, the draft proposal envisages the parish working in a Unit with Church Langley and Potter Street.

For the most part proposals seek to reflect existing working together, and to build on this. As the only full time incumbent in the CM17 (postcode) area, it is anticipated that whoever is appointed will have a major and collaborative role (with clergy and others) in developing this Mission Unit, both locally and in its wider deanery context.

The Deanery is aiming at all Mission Units being fully underway by Easter 2020. Full details of the consultation for the Deanery are available from the Area Dean.

It is anticipated that the CM17 unit will continue to collaborate in existing mission and ministry, as well as taking new initiatives in due course, and working ecumenically where possible. It has been stressed generally that such collaboration is not about diluting worship traditions.

Areas of collaboration so far identified are:

1. Outreach to New Hall and Gilden Park
2. Collaboration in Messy Church
4. Sharing initiatives in Discipleship
5. Youth ministry
6. Schools ministry
